policies.

About APNIC

One of the world's five Regional Internet Registries (RIRs), the Asia Pacific Network Information Centre (APNIC) is responsible for providing vital resource allocation and registration services to the Asia Pacific Internet community.

APNIC allocates and registers IP addresses (IPv4 and IPv6), Autonomous System (AS) numbers, manages reverse DNS delegations, and maintains a public whois database. It is a membership-based, not-for-profit organization and its policies are developed through an open process of consultation and consensus.

APNIC and Internet Governance

The responsible stewardship of critical Internet resources is fundamental to the continued growth, security, and stability of the Internet, Involved with Internet Governance since its inception over ten years ago, APNIC participated in the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) and continues to actively support and participate in the multistakeholder Internet Governance model and the Internet Governance Forum (IGF) processes.

APNIC is an important part of the global Internet community and has strong relationships with other regional and global organizations. APNIC is also a member of the Number Resource Organization (NRO).



Policies are developed to meet the changing needs of the Asia Pacific Internet industry through an open process of community consultation and consensus at APNIC meetings and on APNIC mailing lists.

APNIC administers the Information Society Innovation Fund, a grants program which aims to help advance local and regional innovations that foster Asia Pacific Internet development, particularly in developing economies.



DNS rootservers

APNIC has provided technical and financial support in the deployment over 20 rootservers in the region. This has vastly improved rootserver response times, stability and security for the majority of Asia Pacific service providers and users.
