

IPv4 /8 Address Space Status








IPv4 Allocations RIRs to LIRs/ISPs



Yearly Comparison (Jan 1999 – Sep 2005)





Cumulative Total (Jan 1999 – Sep 2005)





Yearly Comparison (Jan 1999 – Sep 2005)



Cumulative Total (Jan 1999 – Sep 2005)



IANA IPv6 Allocations to RIRs (no of /23s)








IPv6 Allocations RIRs to LIRs/ISPs



Yearly Comparison (Jan 1999 – Sep 2005)






IPv6 Allocations RIRs to LIRs/ISPs



RIR Policy Development Process (Predates ICANN PDP)








The Global PDP (Defined in ASO MoU)




Need	 Current policy promulgated by IETF in 1999 Precedes global PDP
