- Number Resource Organization
 - NRO MoU, 24 Oct 2003
- Addendum signed in July 2020 which include the below agreements:
 - Not to take action that would violate Internet Number Registry System (INRS) uniqueness.
 - To take effective measures to promote Internet INRS.
 - To publish INRS entries publicly, so as to enable timely global Internet operations.
 - To cooperate together in the provision of consistent, effective global INRS

 To be the flagship and global leader for collaborative Internet number resource management as a central element of an open, stable and secure Internet.

- Coordination with the RIR RPKI Steering Group and supervised by the NRO EC.
 - The NRO RPKI Program aims to provide a more consistent and uniformly secure, resilient, and reliable RPKI service to help remove barriers currently experienced by network operators who create RPKI objects through multiple RIRs.

- Contribution to ICANN: USD \$823,000 (IANA Contract USD \$650,000 and voluntary contribution USD \$173,000)

AFRINIC Situation

NRO EC has closely monitored the AFRINIC's situation by

- Providing on-site legal support
- Closed and constant coordination with ICANN Leadership
- Looking for a renewed engagement with Africa Internet community in collaboration with other Internet organizations.
- Supporting the organization of board elections according and respecting Mauritius legal system

AFRINIC has been continuously providing registration services within their region during all this time.



ICP-2 Review

- NRO EC requested to the ASO AC to review the ICP-2 document after more than 2 decades of existence.
- ICP-2Review will focus on:
 - ICP-2 implementation procedures. ICP-2 requirements are also applicable
 to the maintenance of that accreditation, but ICP-2 lacks corresponding
 procedures for the validation of initial or ongoing compliance, for review of
 compliance, or for specific outcomes of a review process.
 - A comprehensive update of ICP-2 Document. A multiannual plan should include an outline on what the process will be, a timeline and how they will engage with the community.
- Documentation is currently in pre-release form but all information will be published in the ASO website.
