

E-mail from Andres : proposal for the LACNIC CRISP Members

Dear Colleagues,

Taking in consideration that the MONC proposal made by LACNIC community could bring some pushback from other members of the group, and having heard about the issues that may be uncomfortable for the rest of the CRISP Members, we would like to propose a compromise idea:

- Eliminating the word Multistakeholder from the language of the proposal.
- Not referring to the Council at the MoU level. We can mention the Council in the CRISP output just as an advisory body created by the NRO-EC for specific oversight purposes.
- The report of the council would not be mandatory for NRO-EC.
- No special seats at the council are reserved for other stakeholders such as Governments.
- The creation of the council should still be referred at CRISP outcome.
- The NRO-EC should ask the RIR communities to appoint 3 members for each region considering diversity.

I hope you can appreciate the effort done by the members of LACNIC community in this group.
